



ON-STREET PARKING SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT

REGULATIONS :

The holder of this permit must abide by the following regulations:

1. This permit **MUST** be visible through the front windshield on the driver's side.
2. The permit provides relief **ONLY** from the parking restrictions granted by the client service center representative. The permit holder **CANNOT** park his/her vehicle in **NO PARKING ZONES (EXEMPTION FOR NO PARKING AREA CAN BE MADE UPON APPROVAL FROM THE DEPARTMENT), NO STOPPING ZONES, DISABLED PARKING ZONES, FIRE ROUTES** or at **PARKING METERS DURING THOSE HOURS WHERE PAYMENT IS REQUIRED.**
3. The applicant is responsible to distribute the permit(s) to their users and to inform them of the limits on the privileges provided by the permit(s).
4. The permit is valid **ONLY** during the period for which it was issued.
5. The permit is **NOT** valid during snow removal, the over-night winter parking ban, and street-sweeping operations.
6. Permits are non-refundable.

Any abuse or infraction of these conditions may result in the revocation of the permit and/or the issuance of a parking ticket.

**ON-STREET RESTRICTIONS
EXTRACT FROM GENERAL REGULATIONS OF BY-LAW 2003-530**

Parking Prohibited - Whether Signs Have Been Erected or Not:

1. in excess of three (3) hours between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.;
2. within 300 metres of previous parking space within one (1) hour;
3. within 9 metres of an intersection;
4. within 3 metres of a fire hydrant;
5. within 1.5 metres of a driveway;
6. on a roadway which is 6 metres or less in width;
7. on any portion of a highway not intended for vehicle parking;
8. during snow removal and street sweeping operations;
9. angle parking is permitted on a highway where the angle has been designated by signs or markings on the roadway
10. no person shall remain parked on any highway where there are parking meters unless such vehicle is parked entirely within the area designated as a parking meter space.

Stopping Prohibited - Whether Signs Have Been Erected or Not:

11. within a pedestrian crossover, within 30 metres of the approach side of a pedestrian crossover or within 15 metres of the leaving side of a pedestrian crossover;
12. within 34 metres of the approach side of a bus stop and within 18 metres of the leaving side of a bus stop;
13. within an intersection or crosswalk;
14. between the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm within 30 metres of the approach side of a school crosswalk and within 10 metres of the leaving side of a school crosswalk and within 10 metres of the leaving side of a school crosswalk;
15. upon a bridge, within an underpass or within 30 metres of any such structure unless parking is otherwise permitted by signs;
16. on or partly on or over a sidewalk;
17. on the right side of the travelled portion of the highway, having regard to the direction in which the vehicle was travelling, with its right front and rear wheels parallel to and not more than 15 centimetres away from such a curb.
